

# Rules of the Adventure Park



## Information

Guests must be at least 4 years of age and able to independently climb without physical or mental limitations. People who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs are prohibited to climb.

We recommend using the restrooms in the brown building across the street before putting on the climbing harness.

Jackets, backpacks and large handbags can be hung on the hooks under the porch.

Valuable objects can get deposited for free in the ticket office. You will get a button for it, with which you can purchase drinks at the forest bar. Payment for purchases will be made when checking out.

- Rental of the personal safety equipment (harness, carabiners, pulley and gloves) will let you enjoy a climbing time of three hours. The equipment is for your use only and not transferable. If there is not enough equipment available, we will communicate this to the central platform. In this case we expect you to promptly return the equipment.
- Smoking or staying close to an open fire can cause burn holes in the security equipment and is prohibited for this reason.
- For hygiene reasons place the equipment in the ticket office before visiting the toilet facilities. The proper tightening of the safety equipment must be checked by one of our staff before climbing again.
- The safety instructions will be conducted orally or by video. People, who do not respect the safety rules or the instructions, can be expelled from the park without refund.
- If you have climbed in our park before during this season, you have only to do the small instruction course.

## Safety

- Staff will check the proper handling of the carabiners and the pulley on the mandatory instruction course.
- Before crossing the red line on the instruction course, the ladders and on the central platform, it is mandatory to hook in the carabiner to be secured.

## Behavior

- Everybody has to start with a green course.
- The ages and course numbers give an indication of the expected levels of difficulty. Skillful climbers can exceed their proposed age level after consultation with the staff on the central platform.
- Only one person is allowed on the obstacles at a time.
- The maximum of three people are permitted on the platforms.
- When riding the zip lines, have one hand always ready to brake on the cable behind the pulley.
- Leave the arrival of the zip lines always as quickly as possible.
- From the course number 9 it gets high and demanding. In these courses, there is no going back. The staff will provide assistance until the next emergency exit.
- If the weather is uncertain, such as lightening or storms, the park will be closed for safety reasons.

With the signing of the form, you or the group leader confirms that the regulations were understood. All participants must have accident insurance.

Place of jurisdiction is Neuhausen.
